

## **Clarifications around some areas that students/parents,guardians, may be unsure about:**

- **If feeling ill in school – what to do?**

Firstly tell your teacher or someone on supervision if not in class.

Your teacher will tell you to go to the foyer. Once there tell Margaret/Delia/Denise that you are ill. She will phone home to have you collected and ask for a time of arrival of parent/guardian. She will ask you what your symptoms are. If you have symptoms of Covid 19 you will be brought to the isolation area (former prayer room) by P or DP. If you don't have symptoms of Covid 19 you wait in the foyer. Parents/guardians should wait in the car and student will be brought out to them.

Please don't phone home on your mobile to tell parent/guardian that you are ill as this will be done from the main office.

If student is feeling ill with any symptoms of Covid 19 prior to school he/she should stay at home and consult a G.P.

### **Signing out during the school day**

If you have a prior appointment e.g. dental etc bring a signed note to your year head. Go the office with the signed note in order to sign out. Parent/Guardian can wait in car and student will be brought out.

### **Entering and leaving school**

5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> year – through LC area

4<sup>th</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year – through main door

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year – through side door

### **Lockers and storage:**

1<sup>st</sup> years have storage in their base rooms and area

2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> will be provided with lockers. Books can be taken or put in lockers **in the morning before first class or at lunchtime only**. Students should maintains social distancing while at lockers. Students can't congregate at lockers. Students will be provided with antibacterial wipes which they should use to clean the outside of locker after use.

We will continue to monitor the use of lockers. If it becomes problematic we will have to look at the use of ebooks instead of bringing books to school.

### **Movement around the school.**

Students should walk on the left and move directly to class once the bell sounds. Students can't gather in groups in the hallways or areas and should maintain social distancing in so far as possible.

Tuesday – TY allowed down town

Thursday – 5<sup>th</sup> years allowed down town

Friday – 6<sup>th</sup> years allowed down town
